The 58th season of the Windhoek Carnival will officially open with the celebration of the **Prinzenball** (Royal Ball) on Friday evening, the 9th April 2010, at which formal occasion the new **Prinzenpaar** (Royal Couple), who reign during the 2010 Carnival season, are introduced to the public.

We will continue to honor the WIKA-tradition established in 1952 and will accordingly conduct a Street Procession through Independence Avenue on Saturday morning. The Motto for the 2010 season is:

As in the past we would like the public to be part of this wonderful event, for which reason we take the liberty of inviting you to participate in this event by entering a float to take part in this procession. Participation is free as usual, but we require you to decorate your float in a humorous way and in line with the spirit of our motto for the year.

Please use this form to register your participation in the Street Procession of the WIKA 2010, which will thus take place on **10th April 2010**. All participants need to meet at Windhoek's Central Railway Station as from 09h00, from where the procession departs at 11h11 sharp. We follow Bahnhof Street to Independence Avenue, where we turn to the South (towards Ausspanplatz), where the procession will end after approximately 2 hours (at about 13h00).

Afterwards, please join us at the "Frühshoppen" at the SKW in Olympia for a good time.

### Conditions of Participation:

1. Maximum height of float not to exceed 4,2m.
2. All wheels are to be secured, by either covering them to the ground level or by walking personnel, who take guard.
3. Traffic Officers, Pedestrians and other Participants, whether taking part or not, shall not be harassed or abused, be it verbally or physically.
4. **Floats shall be decorated in accordance with the carnival theme.**
5. Floats shall report at the Windhoek Railway Station parking area in Bahnhof Street not later than 09h30 on the 10th April 2010. The Procession Organizer and his team will assign you a position within the procession.  
The procession will depart 11h11 sharp!
6. Participation is ultimately subject to the final approval by the Procession Organizer of the WIKA. Any decision by this official will taken at his sole discretion and is final!
7. **The Driver of a Vehicle will not be allowed to consume alcohol! The Procession Organizer of the WIKA can at his sole discretion remove such a vehicle from the procession and the right to legal recourse is reserved!**
8. The WIKA Organizing Committee or the SKW shall not be held responsible or liable (incl. Public Liability) for any claims whatsoever possibly arising from participation in this Procession.
